





#### What is Sukkot?



"You shall celebrate
Sukkot for seven days as
you gather in your crops
and the fruit of your
vineyards."

In autumn people start spending time inside. It's a little too cold to be out without a sweater, and in some places it's even starting to snow. But in the middle of autumn we have a holiday, Sukkot, when we are supposed to stay outside - well, actually in a little

hut, called a sukkah. For a whole week, life revolves around the sukkah. We eat in it, we entertain in it, and in some places, if it's warm enough, people even sleep in the sukkah.

The first two days of Sukkot are just like Shabbat or other holidays. Instead of going to work or school, many people stay home with their families, go to synagogue... and, of course, spend time in the sukkah. Then come five days of Hol HaMo'ed, which are pretty much like regular days when it comes to work or school, but we still try to spend time in the sukkah, at least when we eat and relax. The last day of Hol HaMo'ed is called Hoshana Rabbah. It is a very serious day, with many special customs.

# Significance of Transfiguration Mk 9.9

#### The event confirms and affirms His identity as Messiah

God's Words affirm and confirm His Messiahship, His Person, & His Plan

which the disciples are to keep quiet about this aspect

(due to colloquial understanding of Messiah as political leader)

UNTIL (new truth) He is Risen

Seven Times = \*Mk 1:34, 43-44; 3:11-12; 5:43; 7:36; 8:30; 9.9

They asked Him, saying, "Why is it that the scribes say that Elijah must come first?" And He said to them, "Elijah does first come and restore all things. And yet how is it written of the Son of Man that He will suffer many things and be treated with contempt? "But I say to you that Elijah has indeed come, and they did to him whatever they wished, just as it is written of him."


Excellent footnote (9:11-13) in Ryrie Study Bible:

#### Mark 9:11-13

The progression of thought is this: If Elijah is to come before the last day and "restore the hearts" (Mal. 4:5-6), why should the Son of Man have to die? Christ replied that they were correct about Elijah but that their concept of the Son of Man was deficient, since it did not include the truths of His suffering and death (Ps. 22:6; Isa. 53). Then Christ added (v. 13) that Elijah already had come, and been unrecognized, in John the Baptist. See also note on Matt. 17:11-12.


#### Matthew 17:11-12

The sequence of thought is as follows: (1) Elijah is coming as the restorer (Mal. 4:5); (2) he came, unrecognized, in the person of John the Baptist, and was killed; (3) the Son of Man faces a like fate. The disciples seem to grasp only the first two points.
