## Light in the World Reflected light, not sources of light

Acts 13:46-47 "For so the Lord has commanded us, 'I HAVE PLACED YOU AS A LIGHT FOR THE GENTILES, THAT YOU MAY BRING SALVATION TO THE END OF THE EARTH."

2Cor. 4:6 For God, who said, "Light shall shine out of darkness," is the One who has shone in our hearts to give the Light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Christ.

Eph. 3:8-9-10 and to bring to light what is the administration of the mystery which for ages has been hidden in God who created all things;

Eph. 5:7-9-10 (for the fruit of the Light consists in all goodness and righteousness and truth),


