

Pauls letter to believers in Rome

brethren, we are under obligation, not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh— 13 you are living according to the flesh, you must die; but by the Spirit you are putting to death the deeds of the body, you will all who are being led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God. 15 you have not received a spirit of slavery leading to fear again, but you have received a spirit of adoption as sons by which we cry out, "Abba! Father!" The Spirit Himself testifies with our spirit that we are children of God, 17 and children, heirs also, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him so that we may also be glorified with Him.

John 16:14 "He will glorify Me, for He will take of Mine and will disclose it to you.




