

Greek hints at connection with unique grammar. In all of the NT, the Spirit is always referred to with a masculine gender (not sexual aspect) grammar. Only here vs 26 & 16 does the Greek use a neuter gender pronoun. Designed to catch the eye, to connect.

OBSERVATIONS

- Union with Christ is the source of all our blessings 1 of justification (Rom 4,5), sanctification (Rom 6,7,8), and glorification (Rom 8).
- 2 Believers are the sons of God, objects of His affection, partakers of His moral nature, & joint-heirs of His Glory.
- 3 Suffering and afflictions are not inconsistent with our being sons of God.
- 4 Resting on God's Word in the present is faith, resting on God's Word in the future is hope. Both are sure.
- 5 God is our helper (PARAKLETE) here and in heaven.
- 6 Prayer is always answered, assisted, and conforming with the will of God.
